

Arizona Region of USA Volleyball - 2011 Fees

<u>Membership Type</u>	<u>Cost</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Full Membership - Junior or Regular	\$50	Any individual (Junior or Adult) that is participating for more than 5 consecutive days of the season - including practices and/or tournaments. E.g.. Players, Coaches, Club Directors, Team Reps, and Officials. A player must be a full member to participate in the USA National Championships - except for Seniors 55+ below.
Multi-Day Membership	\$12	Any individual (Junior or Adult) participating from 2-5 consecutive days (including practices and/or tournaments) between Sept 1 and Apr 30. E.g.. Officials working only one 2-5 day tournament the entire season.
One Day Membership	\$7	Any individual (Junior or Adult) participating for not more than one day of the entire 2010-11 season. A player may not pay more than one 1-day membership per season - must upgrade to full member status to participate for another day later in the season. E.g.. An Adult Player subbing on a team for one tournament the entire season. The fee to Upgrade to a Regular membership would be \$43
Summer Membership	\$15	Any individual (Adult or Junior) participating in a league, camp, or tournament between May 1 and August 31 that is sanctioned by USA Volleyball that is not an individual member already. E.g.. A Player that is not a USA Volleyball member that wants to play in the junior beach program or Volleyball Festival.
Training Only Membership	\$25	Any individual that is training only with a club. The player may not participate in any tournaments with the team - even friendship. This is a partial membership for training purposes only - no competition. E.g.. Player that may be too old for the team and is just practicing with them but not able to participate in any tournaments.
Chaperone Membership	\$25	Any adult 25 years or older chaperoning a Junior club team. There is no limit to the number of tournaments chaperoning during the season.
Senior Membership	\$25	Any player 55 years and older whose sole membership is to participate at the USA Volleyball Open National tournament.
Background Screening Fee	\$20	This is per person being screened. All officials and adults associated with a junior club are required to have a Background Screening before they may engage in their role with the junior club. This includes: club directors, coaches, chaperones, team reps, trainers, officials. This is a condition of membership and cannot be waived per USA Volleyball and our insurance carrier. The background screen must be repeated every second consecutive season or if circumstances warrant a second screen in two years.

Team Fees

Adult Team Fee	\$55	This is per team registering in the Arizona Region
Junior Team Fee	\$25	This is per team registering in the Arizona Region

Tournament Contracts

Adult Power Contract	\$850	This includes 5 Power Tournaments plus the Region Championships Must be paid in no more than 2 payments to avoid the single entry fee Paying the contract saves \$50 over the cost of individual tournament entries.
Power Tourney Entry Fee	\$150	This is on a space available basis only. Entry form and fee due 10 days prior to tournament date.
Adult Coed Tournament Entry Fee	\$100	This tournament is a separate tournament entry. The fee is per team and due in the Region Office 10 days before the tournament is scheduled.
Adult Region Championships Entry Fee	\$150	The team entering must have played in 2 of the regular season power tournaments to be eligible for the National Championships entry reimbursement. Only teams that did not pay the Power Contract need to pay this entry fee.
Jr. Boys Contract	\$945	This is per team playing in the AZ Region Power Tournaments. This includes 5 Power Tournaments plus Regionals. Format is pool play followed by single elimination bracket play
Jr. Girls Open Contract	\$820	This is per team playing in the Open Division. This includes 4 Power tournaments plus Regionals. Open Division is for 15's - 18' s teams only. Format is pool play followed by single elimination bracket play.
Jr Girls Championship Divison	\$830	This is per team playing in the Championship Division for ages 14's, 16's and 18's. This includes 6 Power tournaments plus Regionals. Format is wave play. The 14's must qualify at the first tournament to continue in this division. Those not qualifying will be placed in the Club Division. Age groups will mix for Power tournament play and break into individual age divisions for Region Championships.
Jr Girls Club Division	\$830	This is per team playing in the Club Division for ages 12's, 14's & 16's. This includes 6 Power tournaments plus Regionals. Format is wave play. Teams will play in their respective age groups for all tournaments
Nat'l Club Qualifier Entry	\$500	This is per team entering the Arizona Region National Club Qualifier All teams entering the National Club Qualifier will be required to submit

their team's entry fee for the Jr. National Championships to the Region Office within 10 days of qualification. The entries will then be forwarded to USA Volleyball. \$250 will be refunded to teams that complete the NCQ, do not withdraw after the entry deadline and do not forfeit any matches to keep them from finishing in a qualifying position. The 1st place team will be awarded the AZ Region bid to the National Division, the 2nd place team will be awarded the AZ Region bid to the American Division. 3rd place is an alternate in all ages.

Junior Beach

- Beach Program Fee** **\$20** This is per person entering the Beach Program - 12's to Open Div.
- Beach Tournament Entry** **\$10** This is per person entering a beach tournament

Additional Fees and Fines

- IMPACT Clinic Fee** **\$25+** This is per person taking the IMPACT clinic. IMPACT is the minimum certification required for coaching junior volleyball in the Arizona Region. Clinics held from General Assembly - December 30th are \$25 per participant. Any clinic held in January is \$50 per participant. Clinics that are added to take care of additional coaches are \$100 per participant. Subsequent clinic fees will increase.
- Late Fees** **\$100** Clubs that do not make their payments in a timely manner or to meet established deadlines are susceptible to a \$100 per item fine.
- Leaving before completing the team's ref assignment** **\$100** Any team that leaves a tournament before completing their officiating duties will be fined \$100. This fine must be paid before the team may participate in another AZ Region sanctioned event. This includes all Junior and Adult teams.
- No Show Fine** **\$100** Any team that does not notify the Region office of their inability to play in a scheduled tournament by noon Friday prior to the tournament will incur a No Show fine. The fine must be paid before the team may enter another sanctioned tournament. Notification of "no play" for the Region Championships is 10 days prior. This includes all Junior & Adult teams.
- Late Withdrawal Fee** **\$50** Any team that withdraws from a tournament entered within 48 hours of the tournament are subject to a late withdrawal fine. The fine must be paid before the team may enter another sanctioned tournament. This includes all Junior and Adult teams.
