Only water is allowed to be brought in the site. **There is a \$2 charge to enter the park.**

Program Info

- Registration for the Jr Beach program can be completed by: mailing this form with payment to the Region office
OR
online **www.azregionvolleyball.org/beach**.
- Registration for each individual tournament will begin at 5pm the day of . Teams arriving after 5:45pm will not be eligible to participate.
- Play will begin at 6pm. Teams are guaranteed a minimum of 3 matches depending on the number of teams in the tournament.. (If an age division is represented by three or fewer teams, those teams may be asked to play up an age division to ensure more matches. The teams moving up will still be awarded medals for their appropriate age group.)
- Players will officiate their own matches. Officiating clinics will be conducted at the beginning of each tournament. If there is a dispute, it will be settled by the tournament director.
- Teams will earn points using the AVP point system which is dictated by the number of teams in a division at each tournament and their respective finish in each. Medals will be awarded to the top two finishers in each age division at each tournament.

IMPORTANT—PLEASE READ

- **Registration** will begin 1 hour before the scheduled start time. If you arrive later than 5:45pm you will only be able to participate if teams are needed to fill pools.
- **Parent's and Coaches** are NOT permitted on the playing surface at any time. One warning will be given and if not heeded, the players of said parent or coaches will be forfeited from the tournament and could face expulsion from the program.
- All players and parents will be held to the USA Volleyball **Code of Conduct**. Violations of those rules will result in the appropriate sanctions. Alcohol consumption will not be permitted for participants in the Open Division.

Match Format

The tournament format will depend upon the number of teams, age bracket and site and will be determined by the tournament director. Options include one game rally score to 30, one game rally score to 21, one game rally score to 15 or two out of three games rally score to 15 or 21, third game to 15. All games must be won by two points.

Partners

Players do NOT sign up as a teams. They will sign up with their chosen partner at each tournament and only the individuals tournament points will be kept. When the season ends, the top player in each age division will pick their partner for a chance to compete in USAV Junior Beach Nationals in August.

Rules Differences and Officiating

- USA Volleyball Beach Rule & Regulations will be in effect (same as the AVP). You can download the official beach rules at <http://www.usavolleyball.org/content/index/405>.
- Officiating clinics will be conducted before the start of each tournament. Parents and Coaches are welcome to attend these clinics.
- The athletes will be officiating each other. There will be no Region officials used in this program. Please take time to understand the rules differences. Players are asked to be diligent in both officiating and scorekeeping duties. Rules differences will also be posted on the Beach page.

Costs

To register for the Arizona Region Beach program, ***players will be required to pay a \$20 per athlete registration fee*** which covers; tournament insurance, court rentals, administration and site fees. ***Tournament fees are \$10 per player.*** Players only pay for the tournaments in which they play.
